

Character Letters:

Write an informal letter from one character to another.

Discuss one or more of the following topics. You may want to have the second character respond in his/her own letter.

- Describe a problem and ask for solutions in resolving the conflict. Stay in character and write what the character would write.
- Discuss an issue of importance (science, friendship, loyalty, fear, love, etc.) and explain the character's feelings on the topic.
- Imagine you are contacting the character after the chapter's events and you want to help by making predictions and suggestions for the future.
- Explain an incident from the book where an event dramatically changed the character's life and taught him/her something.
- You (as a character) may know something the other character does not know and you attempt to warn or inform this character of what may occur.
