

Writing a thesis in 3 steps:

1. Make the topic specific (Exactly who, when, where, how many)
2. Continue with a debatable phrase (does, does not, should, should not)
3. Explain the significance to the audience (proving that, resulting in, making us doubt, reminding us that)

Ex. The longer school day next year does guarantee more learning opportunities, resulting in increased student success.

Ex. The longer school day next year does not guarantee that students will be productive in classes, reminding us that young people need to find learning meaningful.
